

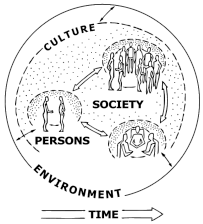
Preliminary Course: The social and cultural world

apply the fundamental concepts to TWO of the following: School, family, media and a group of which the student is a member.

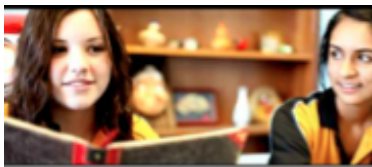


The fundamental course concepts and the interaction between them are important in understanding the society in which we live. To check your understanding of the definition of these important concepts click on the following link and scroll to page 15:
